



In memoriam: Dr. Yu (Eric) Wang (1964-2008)

Dr. Yu Wang, the first student to complete his Ph.D. under my supervision, passed away in late October 2008 after a brief but spirited battle with cancer. He was 44 years old. He received his Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering from Penn State in 2001 for his work on thin-film PZT MEMS accelerometers and silicon bulk-machined strain gauges. Information on the latter appears in his dissertation but has not been published in the regular literature to date.

At this time of his passing he was a Senior Engineer for Maxim Semiconductor Products in Sunnyvale, CA. He is sorely missed by his wife, Quindi, his daughter and son, his many relatives, and his colleagues and friends.
